

Eco-Enrichers

Science – Grade 1-3

Students learn about and observe earthworms.

Materials:

- One earthworm
- Large, damp paper towel
- Magnifying glass
- Spray bottle

Instructions:

- 1. Create a KWL (What I <u>Know</u>, What I <u>W</u>ant to Know, and What I <u>Learned</u>) chart on earthworms.
- 2. Give each child or group of children an earthworm and a damp paper towel. If needed, keep the worms bodies moist by spraying with a spray bottle filled with water.
- 3. Allow time for the children to observe the worm. How does it move? What color is it? What does its skin look like? What does the worm do?
- 4. When finished, complete the KWL chart with the things the children have learned about the earthworms.
