

Guess the Outdoor Object

Math - Grade 1-3

Students measure outdoor objects, and then write clues that other students use to guess the object's identity.

Materials:

- Paper meter stick
- Print outs of the following page
- Pens or Pencils

Instructions:

Have students measure four rectangular outdoor objects using a paper meter stick. Include objects that have measurements greater than 100 cm. They should record their data on the following page. Then have students write a clue for each object about its color, shape, location, or use. Students can ask their partner to guess each of their objects.

** Lesson Enhancement: Have students use their paper meter stick to measure the height of one or more people in their family. They should make a list with the name of each family member and his or her height.
