

# As Big as a... Puma

#### Science – Grade 4-6

## Students create a mural of a life-size puma.

### Materials:

- Puma picture (see following page)
- Pencils
- 54 pieces of 7" x 7" construction paper
- Black markers
- Large area to hang the finished picture

#### Instructions:

- 1. Ahead of time: photocopy the puma picture and cut out the squares. Make another copy for reference.
- 2. Divide the squares up among the students.
- 3. Have students draw what is on their little square onto their 7" x 7" sheet. They should start drawing with a pencil. Have them write the number on the back (with the same orientation).
- 4. When all the squares are completed, use the numbers on the back to arrange them into the picture, then tape them together.
- 5. Have students create a title and add some interesting puma facts to display with the picture.
