



## ***Assemblage: Materials from Nature***

### ***Art – Grade 1-3***

**Students create an assemblage by finding outdoor objects and then use them to create artwork.**

Materials:

- Cardboard
- Glue
- Paper
- Pens, pencils, crayons, markers, etc

Instructions:

1. Have students look for natural objects outside (leaves, grass, sticks, etc) that look like different parts of an animal's body.
2. Students should try putting the materials together in different ways by arranging them on cardboard.
3. Glue the parts of the creature to the cardboard.
4. Now have students make a drawing of their assemblage.
5. Place the drawing next to the assemblage and have students answer the following questions:
  - a. How is your drawing like your assemblage?
  - b. How is it different?
6. Have students in the class share their work.
