



What Happens Next?

Art – Grade 1-3

Students tell their own story by drawing a series of three pictures in which some shapes stay in the same place in each picture, and other shapes move in order to tell the story.

Materials:

- Three sheets of paper per student
- Pencils, crayons, markers, etc

Instructions:

1. Have students think of an outdoor activity that they can draw a story about (i.e., hiking, camping, biking, playing in the backyard, etc).
2. Students each take three sheets of paper and plan each scene. What shapes will stay the same in each scene? Draw these first.
3. Draw other shapes into the scenes to tell the story.
4. Look at all the pictures together and tell the story to the class.
